LMPD Significant Arrest – Robbery

(LOUISVILLE, Ky. June 19, 2024) —

On June 18, 2024, LMPD Robbery Unit Detectives, with the assistance of Mt. Sterling Police Department, arrested Tommy Jerome Hardin (B/M, DOB: 03/25/1973), in Mt. Sterling Kentucky.

On 06/10/2024, Mr. Hardin robbed two business in the 5th Division (House of Gelish Nails and Bearnos Pizza). Robbery Detectives conducted multiple search warrants in Montgomery County, KY, and in Bath County, KY, which yielded evidence in both robberies.

Mr. Hardin has been charged with Robbery 1st Degree and is being held in the Montgomery County Jail.

Mr. Hardin is a violent career criminal. In 2003, Mr. Hardin committed 33 business robberies throughout Metro Louisville. He was convicted in 2005 and served 20 years of a 40-year sentence. He was paroled in 2022. He also has past robbery convictions in Warren, Meade, Nelson, Hardin, and Daviess Counties in Kentucky.
