






Top 3 Topics Breakdown








Additional Open-Text Analysis

The following section provides additional analysis by identifying themes from open-ended responses and interpreting "Other" entries in multiple-choice questions with more than 50 responses, uncovering less common but meaningful themes.


What is the name of the street/park/station/area where you feel unsafe?

When asked about specific locations where respondents feel unsafe, the **downtown area** was mentioned most frequently. **Taylor Blvd** was the most frequently mentioned street name, and **Victory, and Shelby Parks** were the most frequently mentioned parks.


Most Commonly Mentioned **Areas**

(# of Responses)




Most Commonly Mentioned **Parks**
(# of Responses)




Why do you consider this place unsafe?

712 respondents answered this question




When asked why they consider the place unsafe, social media or news reports were the most frequently selected options, making up 48% of responses. This was closely followed by reports of personally witnessing or experiencing a crime, at 44%. The 'Other' option comprised 9% of all responses to the question. Among these 'Other' selections, **personally witnessing or being a victim of a crime** were the most frequently mentioned reasons:

Why do you consider this place unsafe? (*'Other'* responses)




When asked to provide additional information about the place they consider unsafe, concerns over **violence and criminal activity** were mentioned most frequently, followed by requests for a **stronger police presence, stricter enforcement**, and **improved community relations**. Additionally, **258 respondents noted they have nothing else to add**.

What concerns, if any, would you have about applying to become a Louisville Police Officer?

1153 respondents answered this question



When asked about concerns related to applying for a position as a Louisville Police Officer, 45% of responses indicated a lack of interest in the role, making it the most frequently selected option. This was followed by 31% who felt that the position did not align with their skills.

The 'Other' option comprised 11% of all responses to the question. Within these 'Other' responses, being **overage** was the most frequently mentioned reason. Additionally, two respondents did not specify a reason, one noted they do not plan to live in Louisville long-term, and one indicated a lack of interest.
